GERERAL RULES

1. White River Primary is a government school which is run according to recognised guidelines. No learner will be refused admission on grounds of race, colour or creed.
2. White River Primary is a dual medium school with English and Afrikaans as the mediums of instruction. **These two languages are the only languages to be used during all school activities on the school grounds.**
3. All learners are expected to respect and obey the school rules and to sign the Code of Conduct.
4. Learners must respect property and other people's possessions.
5. Learners must attend school regularly and will only be excused on account of their own illness or the death of a close relative. Parents are required to explain the reason for absence in writing. Doctor and dentist appointments must be made after school hours. During examinations and term tests a doctor's certificate must be provided if a learner is absent or the learner will forfeit his/her marks.
6. Learners may not leave the school grounds during school hours without permission from the principal (or, in his absence, a deputy principal).
7. If a learner falls ill during school hours, he/she has to report to the office with his/her homework diary which the teacher has signed. A learner will be signed out when fetched by a parent. Parents are kindly requested not to deviate from these rules and to keep sick learners at home – DON'T send sick children to school.
8. Pornography, smoking or the use of alcohol or drugs are prohibited on the school grounds.
9. No dangerous weapons or toys e.g. knives, firearms or handmade weapons are allowed on the school grounds.
10. Learners are not allowed to throw stones, clods or dangerous objects.
11. No learner may litter the school grounds.
12. Learners may not communicate with people outside the school other than through the office during school hours.
13. All clothing and possessions **MUST** be clearly marked with the learner's name. Lost property is handed in at the office. After three months, unclaimed lost property, will be handed over to the uniform shop to be sold. The school is not responsible for lost property.
14. The school's uniform shop has reasonably priced uniforms available.

15. School uniform must be worn as prescribed.
16. School hours:
Starts 07h20 (punctuality is expected at all times – gates will be locked).
Ends Gr 1-2: 13h00 Monday to Friday
Gr 3-7 13h35 Monday to Friday
17. Foul language and bullying (physical or verbal) are not allowed. Strong action will be taken against offenders.
18. No rioting, protesting or mass-action will be allowed on the school premises.
