



# SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY: GIRLS

## WARM DAYS

### MONDAY, WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY

- Green and white checked dress (not shorter than 4cm above the knee).
- Dark green **panties** / ski pants underneath the dress.
- Short green **socks**.
- Black **school shoes** – No tekkies with dress.
- May come to school **barefoot** with dress. Provincial jacket (current year) may only be worn on **Mondays**.

### TUESDAY & THURSDAY

- Step-out shirt and skirt.
- White socks.
- Tekkies – White.
- May come to school **barefoot**.

## COLD DAYS

### MONDAY, WEDNESDAY & FRIDAYS

- Green and white check **dress** (not shorter than 4cm above the knee).
- Dark green **panties** / ski pants underneath the dress.
- Short green **socks** / green “tights” / long green school socks.
- Black **school shoes** – No tekkies with dress.
- May come to school **barefoot** with dress.
- Prescribed **school jersey** / “pull over” / **school tracksuit jacket** may be worn with dress.
- **Provincial jacket** (current year) may only be worn on Mondays.
- **No tracksuit pants may be worn on these days.**

### TUESDAY & THURSDAYS

- Step-out **shirt and skirt**.
- White **socks**.
- Tekkies – white (no other shoes).
- May come to school **barefoot**.
- **Prescribed school jersey** / “pull over” / **school tracksuit jacket may be worn with step-outs.**
- **Tracksuit pants may only be worn with white tekkies, not with school shoes or barefoot.**

## SPORT MEETINGS

- Learners who attend school sport meetings as **spectators** must always wear any one of the prescribed school wear sets.

- Learners who **participate** in sport meetings must always wear sportswear specifically prescribed for the sport code.

## HAIR

- Hair must be **clean and neat and must not hang in the eyes or over the collar**.
- **Longer hair** (collar length) must be tied back.
- **ONLY bottle green, white or yellow black ribbons** and head bands are permissible.
- **NOTHING else** may be worn in the hair. (No beads)
- **NO gels or oils** are allowed.

- **NO bleached or hi-lights** allowed in hair.
- **Hair colour** may not, under any circumstances, be changed.
- **Thin hair extensions** (max 30 cm lengths) **allowed with ethnic hair but must be tied back (not thicker than your own wrist)**.
- **Extensions used must be as close as possible to natural hair colour**
- The following hair styles are allowed for ethnic hair: **“straight up” and “twist”**. **NO “carrots”**.
- **NO other hair patterns, no wigs, no bongo plaiting**

## OTHER RULES

- **NO lip gloss, Coloured “lip-ice” or any make up** is allowed.
- **NO jewelry** or ornamental earrings may be worn.
- **ONLY small sleepers and studs without stones—one per ear** is allowed.
- **ONLY watches, Medic-Alert and Jesus bands** may be worn.

- **NO bands, rings, necklaces, fashion watches and chains** are allowed.
- Clothes must, always, **be clean and in a good condition**.
- The School Uniform Policy must always be adhered to — **even after school hours** (e.g. school shoes cannot be replaced with sandals after school).

## NOT ADHERING TO SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

White River Primary is a proud school. We are proud of our school grounds, our teachers and our parents. Above all, we are proud of our learners. We are proud of their academic achievements-, sport- and extra mural achievements. We want to be proud of their appearance as our learners are the ambassadors of our school. To enable us to achieve this, the management of the school has decided that the School Uniform Policy will be implemented and strictly adhered to. A learner will be punished with **2 demerits** if her appearance does not adhere to the school uniform policy. A learner will be punished with **2 demerits** if her appearance is not in accordance to the school uniform policy. If the uniform policy is not adhered to outside school hours, the same punishment will be applicable.
